**DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP AFFIDAVIT**

**DEFINITION OF DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP:**

A Domestic Partnership shall exist between two persons of the same or different gender, one of whom is a student living in housing at the Pacific School of Religion. Each of the two persons shall be the domestic partner of the other if they both complete, sign, date, and file with the Pacific School of Religion Housing Office an Affidavit of Domestic Partnership attesting to the following:

- a. the two parties share the same legal residence and share the common necessities of life;
- b. the two parties are: not married to anyone; eighteen years or older; not related by blood closer than would bar marriage in the State of California; and mentally competent to consent to contract;
- c. the two parties declare that they are each other's sole domestic partner and they are responsible for their common welfare;
- d. the two parties agree to notify Pacific School of Religion if there is a change of circumstances attested to in the affidavit;
- e. The two parties affirm, under penalty of perjury, that the assertions in the affidavit are true to the best of their knowledge.

**TERMINATION:**

A member of a Domestic Partnership may end said relationship by filing a Statement of Termination of Domestic Partnership, affirming under penalty of perjury that:

- 1) the partnership is terminated, and
- 2) a copy of the termination statement has been mailed to the other partner.

**NEW STATEMENTS OF DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP:**

No person who has filed an Affidavit of Domestic Partnership may file another such affidavit until six (6) months after a statement of termination of the previous partnership has been on file with Pacific School of Religion's Personnel Office.

**AFFIDAVIT OF DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP**

All of the statements made in this Affidavit are true and will remain true indefinitely.

We share the same legal place of residence, and we intend to continue to do so indefinitely. Currently it is at \_\_\_\_\_.

We have reached the age of 18, and neither of us is married or has another domestic partner. We are not related by blood so close as to bar marriage in the State of California and are mentally competent to consent to contract.

We are each others sole domestic partner and intend to remain so indefinitely and are responsible for our common welfare.

Each of us agrees to immediately notify Pacific School of Religion in writing if there is any change of circumstances attested to in this Affidavit. We agree to inform Pacific School of Religion should our partnership be dissolved.

Each of us understands that, if either of us has made a false statement regarding his or her qualifications as a domestic partner or has failed to comply with the terms of the Affidavit, and Pacific School of Religion suffers any loss thereof, Pacific School of Religion may bring a civil action against either or both of us to recover its losses, including reasonable attorneys fees and court costs.

Each of us declares under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the assertions in the Affidavit are true and correct to the best of our knowledge.
