

Application for Special Student Status

Instructions and Requirements

If you are not enrolled in a degree or certificate program at PSR and would like to take courses for academic credit, you may apply for special student status. Under such status a student may enroll in a maximum of two classes per semester. Special students are not eligible for financial aid or for PSR housing. Application instructions and requirements are subject to change.

Special student status is available for people who:

1. Need to take polity/history/theology classes in order to satisfy denominational requirements.
2. Are uncertain about vocational goals and which degree program best suits their needs, yet desire to take courses for credit.
3. Are currently enrolled at another seminary and wish to take courses for credit at PSR.
4. Wish to take graduate theological courses for personal development and enrichment.

All course limitations and prerequisites apply. The Assistant Dean for Academic Programs will determine eligibility and appropriateness for each course. When courses are limited, priority will be given to students enrolled in a degree or certificate program. PSR reserves the right to deny admission to any applicant at any time.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Applications must be complete at least two weeks prior to the beginning of the semester.

Along with the application form, please send the following to the PSR Admissions Office.

- A non-refundable \$50 processing fee payable to Pacific School of Religion
- A typed statement explaining why you are applying to PSR and why you wish to take the indicated course(s) for credit
- An official transcript from your undergraduate institution. (A bachelor's degree is required with a minimum GPA of 3.0 from an accredited institution.) This requirement is waived for individuals currently enrolled in an accredited, graduate program of study.

Renewal of Special Student status

Applicants need to submit the Application for Special Student Status (with processing fee, official transcript, and typed statement) only once. This application is to take a specific course or two for a specific semester. Special student status must be renewed in order to register for classes in subsequent semesters. Renewal of special student status is contingent upon maintaining a 3.0 GPA or better and approval from the Assistant Dean for Academic Programs. Students wishing to apply to a degree or certificate program can only transfer a maximum of 12 units taken as a special student.
