Fall 2020: Important Dates

- **September 8th** – First day of Fall 2020 semester!
- **September 18th**
 - Last day of Late Registration
 - Statement of Understanding due to Registrar's Office
 - Tuition Due or you need to set up a payment plan
 - Last day to apply for a Leave of Absence
 - Last day to add/drop courses online
 - **\$\$ Deadline to Drop Courses with a full refund \$\$**
- **October 2nd** – Last day to drop a course with ½ refund – no refunds after this date!
- **October 26th – 30th** – Reading Week: NO CLASSES
- **November 13th** – **LAST DAY TO DROP A CLASS** or make any changes to a course
- **December 18th** – Last day of Fall 2020 Semester!



New Student Registration Info:

- Students generally register after meeting with their advisor
 - Students should take the courses recommended by their advisors
 - If a student needs to register part-time, they should work with the Assistant Dean for Academic Affairs and Registrar to stay on track.
- Students have until the second week of the term to register for courses. *There will be no new registrations accepted after September 18th, 2020.*

On PSR's homepage, you can click on Courses and then "Courses By Semester".

“Remote” versus “Online”

- **Remote:** courses that meet through Zoom on a weekly basis and some content is delivered through Moodle.
- **Online:** course numbers will be listed in the 8000's. These courses are delivered 100% through Moodle with no weekly sessions.

Future Registration:

Every semester has two registration periods:

Early Registration: This happens during the 10th and 11th week of the semester prior to the semester you are registering for.

For example: Early registration for Spring 2021 will take place
November 9th – November 20th

General/Late Registration: General Registration is the two weeks before the start of any given semester and Late Registration is the two weeks after. You must be registered and attending all classes by the end of the late registration period.

Intersession and Summer Session Registration: Students register during the preceding Early Registration for courses taking place during the Summer or Intersession terms.
