Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund – Student Disclosure

- 1.** Pacific School of Religion has signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the Department of Education for funding under the CRRSAA and ARP programs. These programs allow for grants to students through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF).
- 2.** Pacific School of Religion is approved for \$12,221 in funding from CRRSAA (HEERF II) and \$29,915 in funding from ARP (HEERF III). \$42,136 total funding for students.
- 3.** \$22,279 has been distributed to students. This comprised of \$12,221 in HEERF II student funding and \$10,058 in HEERF II Institutional funding used as additional emergency student grants.
- 4.** 44 students were eligible for funding.
- 5.** 28 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant from HEERF II or HEERF III funding.
- 6.** All residential students who completed a 20-21 FAFSA form and were enrolled at the time the pandemic was declared on 3-13-2020 were reviewed. Refunds were immediately generated for direct payment to the students through bill.com.
- 7.** Students were advised they may use an emergency grant to pay for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or childcare.
