Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund – Student Disclosure

- 1. Pacific School of Religion has signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the Department of Education for funding under the CRRSAA and ARP programs. These programs allow for grants to students through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF).
- 2. Pacific School of Religion is approved for \$12,221 in funding from CRRSAA (HEERF II) and \$29,915 in funding from ARP (HEERF III). \$42,136 total funding for students.
- 3. \$31,121 has been distributed to students.
- 4. 102 students were eligible for funding.
- 5. 59 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant from HEERF II or HEERF III funding.
- 6. All students enrolled for the Fall 2021 semester were reviewed with priority given to students who demonstrated high financial need. Refunds were immediately generated for direct payment to the students through bill.com.
- 7. Students were advised they may use an emergency grant to pay for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or childcare.
