SCIENTIFIC TESTING GUIDELINE & PERMISSION FOR TESTING/SAMPLING

The Badè Museum of Biblical Archaeology requires adherence to the following policy, and completion and approval of this permission form in order to conduct scientific tests on objects in its holdings.

Scientific testing on objects in the Badè Museum of Biblical Archaeology is allowed when such tacting provides data otherwise unotteinable through non-destructive mans. Non-destructive

testing provides data otherwise unattainable unough non-destructive means. Non-destructive			
material science testing, or minimally invasive sampling, is encouraged and may be permitted for			
whole or relatively complete objects. Fragmentary objects may be sampled, however those			
samples may be used in destructive testing only if deemed appropriate by the staff of the			
Museum and approved by the Director. Copies of the unpublished data received from testing			
and of any publications that include data from Museum samples must be provided to the			
Museum. After publication, or the lapse of 2 years after testing, these data may be added to our			
Museum's database, which is open access under Creative Commons licensing.
