PSR transforms individuals and communities through a flexible, stackable curriculum and a collaborative, lifelong learning ecosystem powered by diversity.

PSR offers multiple options for anyone looking to build spiritually grounded leadership skills or learn from wisdom-based traditions. In addition to PSR's doctoral, masters, and certificate programs, PSR also offers non-degree bearing certificates and microcertificates through our online learning platform, PSR Collective. PSR's Centers include Theological Education for Leadership (TEL), whose primary offering, the Congregational Renewal Cohort, inspires creativity amongst church leaders for meaningful growth. The Center for LGBTQ+ and Gender Studies in Religion (CLGS) celebrated its 25th anniversary this year as the first seminary-based LGBTQ+ Center. The Ignite Institute is PSR's innovative center which launched the online learning platform, Kwaray, in 2024 to reimagine theological education. PSR is also home to the Badè Museum of Biblical Archaeology.

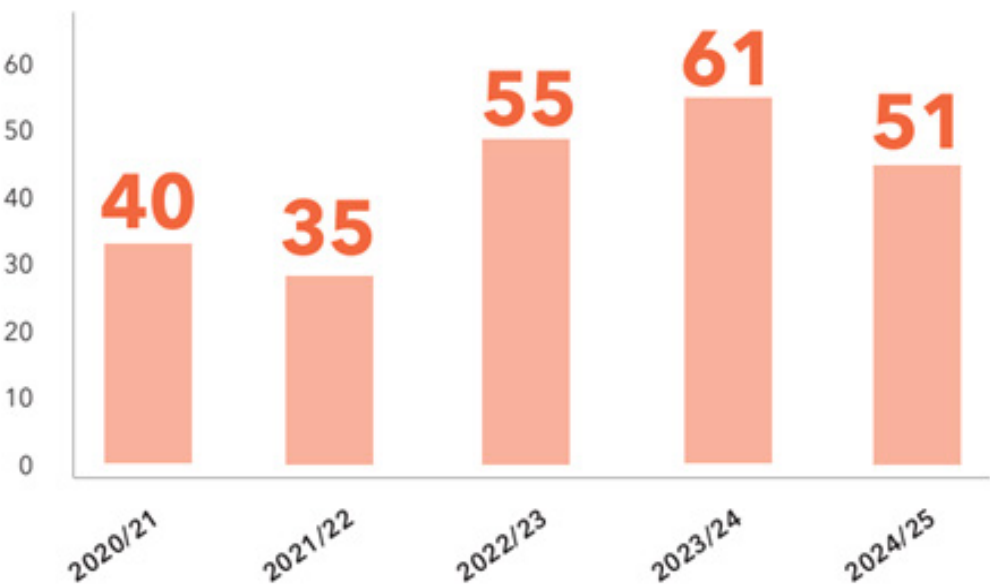
Total Graduate Enrollment

5-Year New Student Growth

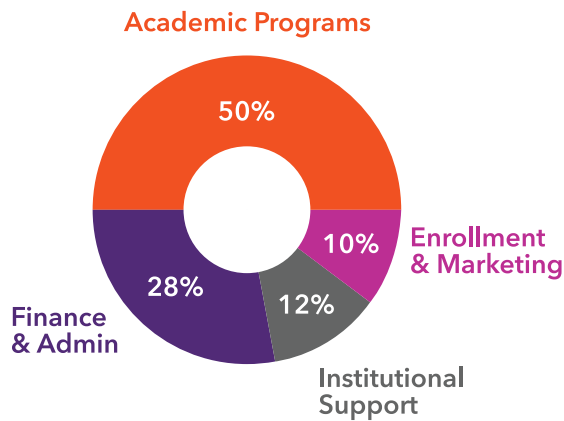


2025 Fiscal Year in Review Financial Statements

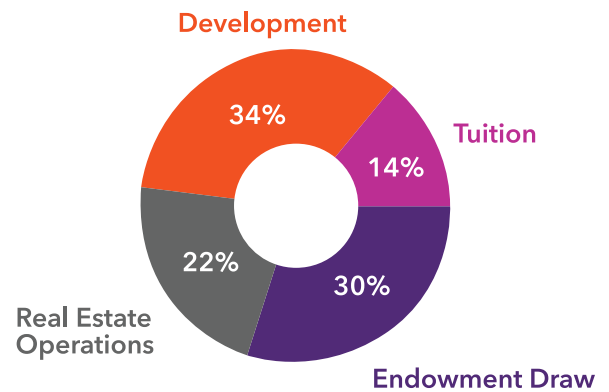
Overall Financial Goals

As an institution, PSR is committed to meeting a “double-bottom line” of delivering on our mission while achieving financial sustainability. Thanks to your generous support, grant awards, growing enrollment, and good stewardship of our resources in 2025 (A fiscal year is a 12-month period for budgeting and financial reporting, we achieved another year of break-even operations).

Revenue: \$9,019,932



Surplus: \$154,382

An operating surplus provides us critically needed resources to invest in “regenerating the ecosystem” of theological education, offering an innovative stackable approach to our graduate education as well as developing an extensive distributed network and collective of learners and partners.

2025 Distinguished Alumnx Awards

Since 1866, PSR has prepared bold and spiritual leaders to serve at the intersections of faith, justice, and compassion. The Distinguished Alumnx Awards recognize graduates whose ministries embody PSR's values of transformative service, theological depth, and prophetic leadership. This year's honorees represent a diverse range of ministries: from congregational renewal to reproductive justice, interfaith advocacy to trans Latina empowerment, and ethical leadership in healthcare. Emerging Paths of Being, Doing & Disruption

In April, the Office of Academic Affairs presented the Unafraid Symposium, the fourth annual gathering to celebrate academic excellence at PSR. This year's theme was **Emerging Paths of Being, Doing & Disruption**. This year's Symposium was held in honor of Rev. Dr. Dorsey Odell Blake. Presentations throughout the day featured selections from students in Dorsey's classes.

We are living in a turbulent time of political upheaval and planetary crisis. The urgency for progressive theological voices and spiritually rooted leaders to respond has perhaps never been greater. The Unafraid Symposium invited scholar-activists, faith leaders, and prophetic thinkers—emerging and experienced alike—to courageously engage this moment with creativity, forging new ways of being, acting, and disrupting the status quo.

The theme of emerging reflects a transgressive process of becoming—of waiting, breaking through, and transforming. To courageously ask: "Emerging from what? For what? And to what?" It challenges us to consider how divine paths of disruption, queering, and creating redefine faithful witness in times of upheaval.

The establishment of CLGS marked another very significant step in PSR's commitment to justice for all of God's children.

The Badè Museum of Biblical Archaeology and the Archaeological Research Facility at UC Berkeley kicked off their annual lecture series, Disability in the Ancient Middle East and Mediterranean.

Spring Student Awards

Earl Lecture Series

This year's theme was Migration: Shaping the Narrative. Through a combination of lectures, workshops, and connections, we explored how stories of migration—past and present—can reclaim power, resist erasure, and shape more just and compassionate futures. We asked what it meant to center lived experience, shift dominant narratives, and take collective action toward a world where all belong.

The event began with the 2025 Distinguished Alumnx Banquet, followed by a day of Earl Lectures that included engaging speakers, thoughtful discussion, and community workshops.
